ENROLLMENT SNAPSHOT

- Overall enrollment up approximately 40 students.
- This includes roughly 70 new undergraduates (first-time and transfer).
- Total Graduate School enrollment is up from last year.
- Housing deposits are up 72 more than last year at this time.





FINANCE UPDATE

FY 2024 Highlights

- Revolving reserve kept whole at maximum amount allowed by BOR policy
- Deferred maintenance account balance increased
- Auxiliary ending fund balance increased by \$500k

FY 2025 Highlights


- Increase of \$2.5M in current unrestricted budget
- Possibilities funded positions and operating resolved
- Increase of 10% for adjunct faculty pay
- Submitted to OCHE for Board of Regent approval in September

- Heating system upgrade
- Three weeks behind due to watermain
- Park Street currently closed, likely not fully open until mid-September

LRBP ON THE MOVE

- ThinkOne Architects and Anderson Mason Dale Architects selected
 - Master Plan for campus and Montana Tech bundle projects
 - On campus last week for initial discovery of Main and Engineering Halls
 - Discovery, analysis, assessment and investigation over the next 6 months
 - Opportunities for input for campus community and Butte community
 - Master Plan completed in Spring 2025
 - Planning, design, construction contractor selection for Main and Engineering Halls continues through 2025
 - Tentative construction start of 2026 with minor projects potentially earlier
