TURNITIN TRAINING SESSION

Montana Technological University subscribes to Turnitin, text-matching identification software that can help instructors detect the presence of plagiarism, contract cheating, and Al-generated text in students' papers. Please note that the latter function does not preclude the permitted use of Al in assignment creation; instead, it opens up possibilities for critical thinking around the ethical and transparent use of Al-generated content in university coursework. Turnitin also simplifies remote assignment submission and comes with built-in electronic grading functions that significantly speed up the marking process. The next Turnitin training session is scheduled for **Friday, August 23** from 1:00 until 2:30 in Engineering Hall room 106. Please consider attending this session if you are curious about Turnitin's Al detection and grading tools, have never used Turnitin, or want a Turnitin refresher.
