MULTI-FACTOR AUTHENTICATION (MFA)

Multi-Factor Authentication (MFA) is now becoming a requirement most on-line account access for security verification. Montana Tech currently requires the use of DUO authentication for Staff and Faculty account access and supports MS Authenticator for Microsoft's Self Service Password Reset Tool (SSPR) used for unlocking or resetting your Tech account. The IT Department is busily making preparations this summer to replace our current Single Sign On (SSO) platform and replace DUO with MS Authenticator. Stay tuned for updates on this project.
