The Mail/Copy Center also has a great assortment of Forever Stamps and USPS Priority boxes for your holiday mailing needs!

Please just keep in mind that the Mail/Copy Center has recently implemented a **72 hour** hold period, after which any unclaimed items can be considered refused and returned to sender. This is especially important to be aware of during the holiday season, with the increase in packages coming daily and our limited shelf space. Please, watch your tracking info and your email to see when your packages arrive so you can claim them in a timely manner!

Ensure the shipping address **includes your name** and is addressed to 1300 W. Park St. STE A, Butte MT 59701, and your holiday cheer will be safe with us!
