

## Petition to Apply Credits Taken as Undergraduate to Graduate Program

For Application of Graduate Level Courses Transfer

## Per Montana Tech Catalog: Courses taken at Montana Tech as an undergraduate student:

For students who have applied to the Montana Tech Graduate School, graduate level courses (400 and 500 level) taken prior to completion of a bachelor's degree may be applied toward any graduate program requirements with the approval of the department head and concurrence of the Graduate School.

## These courses must meet the following criteria:

- Courses must have been taken at Montana Technological University (no transfer credits).
- Up to 9 credits may be double counted towards both the undergraduate and graduate curriculum, credits applied for the
- graduate degree must meet program/department standards for the graduate degree.
- A grade of "B" or better must have been earned for each course.
- Courses must be electives and not part of the core curriculum for the undergraduate degree.
- Courses must have been taken in the past 5 years.
- Partial course credit could be applied, similar to course substitution.
