□ This program is highly competitive – not all qualified applicants will gain acceptance to the program

□ Selection is based solely on a 100-point selection system – qualified applicants earning the most points will be selected for clinical placement in the program

- → Point System: 75% from selective GPA of required prerequisite courses
 25% from proper submission & content of application materials
- → Notification will occur *after* Spring semester final grades post; notification will be via email by mid-June 2025 *the decision of the selection committee is final*

□ All selected students will be required to submit a clear background check (at student's expense - \$40)

• Directions on obtaining a background check is sent to accepted students

Selected students may be required to submit for a drug screen for clinical entrance (at program's expense)

COVID-19 Vaccination Attestation: some clinical facilities are required to report how many students are vaccinated against COVID-19 and may request declaration of vaccination status as a part of the clinical admission process. While COVID-19 vaccination status is not required for program placement, it may be requested for clinical placement.

□ Some affiliated clinical facilities may annually require seasonal flu vaccinations or appropriate declination

□ Clinical site assignments are made after program selections and are for the entirety of the 4-semester program – students *cannot* be guaranteed a preferred clinical site (Current sites: Miles City, Glendive, Sidney)

Selected students will start the program Fall semester 2025: all program courses must be complete in the semester offered; there is no part-time enrollment in the program, or variations to the curriculum – the program is four full-time semesters including the summer semester, with a Fall (December 2026) graduation

□ The radiologic technology program is demanding and rigorous. Many requirements exceed general Montana Tech student requirements – attendance, travel, no program course repetition, clinical hour expectations, uniforms, grade expectations, etc. Clinical hours may be scheduled on days, weekends and evenings. There are extra expenses associated with this program. Students are responsible for all travel expenses and must have dependable vehicle/travel arrangements – including preparedness for winter travel.

□ Clinical students are involved in direct patient care experiences, therefore the expectation for professional behavior is of utmost importance. Following professional standards like punctuality, appropriate hygiene/ appearance, demonstrating empathy, and using appropriate communication and behavior are critical to success, and are part of student assessment and grading. Students are guests at their assigned clinical site; and performance there determines if this program stays viable.

□ Notifications are via email – all applicants will receive an email regarding acceptance status – this information will only be communicated via email, do not call or email to check on your application status – you will be contacted as soon as possible – those selected are required to confirm acceptance within one week of notification (so check your email frequently!)
