☐ Selected students will start the program Fall semester 2025: all program courses must be complete in the semester offered; there is no part-time enrollment in the program, or variations to the curriculum – the program is four full-time semesters including the summer semester, with a Fall (December 2026) graduation
The radiologic technology program is demanding and rigorous. Many requirements exceed general Montana Tech student requirements – attendance, travel, no program course repetition, clinical hour expectations, uniforms, grade expectations, etc. Clinical hours may be scheduled on days, weekends and evenings. There are extra expenses associated with this program. Students are responsible for all travel expenses and must have dependable vehicle/travel arrangements – including preparedness for winter travel.
Clinical students are involved in direct patient care experiences, therefore the expectation for professional behavior is of utmost importance. Following professional standards like punctuality, appropriate hygiene/appearance, demonstrating empathy, and using appropriate communication and behavior are critical to success, and are part of student assessment and grading. Students are guests at their assigned clinical site; and performance there determines if this program stays viable.
